MATT EMULSION APPLICATION GUIDELINE

Substrate Preparation

All loose, flaking and unstable material must be identified and then thoroughly removed. All surfaces must be thoroughly washed down with clean cold water using a pressure washer to remove all surface dirt and dust. All surface defects and cracks must be repaired using Zydex recommended compounds only. When all surfaces are clean, dry, dust free and free from all surface contaminants, painting may proceed. For repainting, surface preparation must be done in accordance with procedure laid down by the Zydex representative or authorised partner.

Application

Matt Emulsion must be applied as two coat system. Both coats can be diluted between 30-40 percent using Potable Water depending on surface. The second coat is to be applied with a minimum gap of 12 hours between coats. Cover all surfaces which are not to be painted, in particular those that are mineral in nature such as glass, stone, ceramics etc.

Consumption

Approximately 4.6 m²/ltr (50 sq.ft./ltr) for 2 coats.

Consumption guideline is quoted for smooth surfaces with normal absorbency. Actual consumption may vary based on surface characteristics and is the responsibility of the applicator.

Cleaning of Equipment

Clean immediately with water after use.

Packaging and Storage

1 ltr, 4 ltr and 20 ltr.

Shelf life approximately 48 months in a cool shaded area. All unused paint must be packed in smaller air-tight containers to maintain minimum air volume.
